

Yassa Onion Sauce** (from People Magazine)

2 Tbsp. Vegetable Oil
2 (9 oz.) Yellow Onions, thinly sliced
½ fresh Scotch Bonnet or Habanero Chile, seeded if desired
1 Tbsp. minced Fresh Ginger (I used the squeeze tube)
½ tsp Kosher Salt
2 Tbsp. Sherry Vinegar (I used actual Sherry)
2 tsp Fresh Lime Juice (1 lime)

Heat 2 Tbsp. oil in large skillet over medium high heat. Add onions; cook, stirring occasionally until softened and translucent ~ about 5 minutes.

Reduce heat to medium low; cook, stirring constantly until onions begin to turn a deep golden brown ~ about 20 minutes.

Add chili, ginger and salt; cook stirring occasionally ~ about 2 minutes.

Add vinegar and lime juice; cook, stirring constantly for 1 minute.

Remove from heat, discard chili, and enjoy!

**I made a double batch and froze the leftovers. I'll put them in a skillet to warm and to remove the extra water from thawing.
