"The Edelweiss Sisters" - Kate Hewitt (May 2021)

This was best book I've read in a long time. Author writes so well; a gripping historical fiction. She moves the story along, portraying superbly the very different characters of the three young adult Austrian sisters at the beginning of Hitler's takeover of their country. As they mature and Austria's situation becomes intolerable for the people, each sister takes very different paths to cope/rebel and ends up in dire circumstances with the Nazis.
