#### **Oreo Bundt Cake**

1 pkg Oreo cookies

4 eggs

Mix in bowl, then place in blender.

Add 1 cup milk and 1/2 cup oil. Blend till fully combined.

Pour into mixing bowl and add 1 cup flour and 1 teaspoon baking powder.

Mix well. Pour into greased Bundt pan and bake.

400 for 35 minutes or till toothpick comes out clean.

Serve with whipping cream or ice cream.
