I adapted this from the Costco Magazine recipe for Tilapia Fish Cakes since I had tuna in my pantry- Sandy

Tuna Fish Cakes (eggless)

2 cans Chunk Light Tuna in Water (Or any tuna in water you have)

Salt & Pepper to Taste
1/3 Cup Mayonnaise
3/4 Cup Breadcrumbs (a little less)
1 Tbsp. Spicy Brown Mustard

1 Tbsp. Fresh Dill, chopped or 1 tsp Dried Dill

1 Tbsp. Fresh Parsley, chopped or

1 tsp Dried Parsley

1/4 Cup Green or Yellow Onion, finely chopped

Zest and Juice of 1 Lemon Oil for frying (I used Canola)

Drain the tuna and put it on paper towels to dry it out more.

Put tuna in a mixing bowl and add the rest of the ingredients. Mix thoroughly. Form into patties (you should get 6 medium sized patties).

Coat the skillet with oil and heat over medium heat. Fry for 2-3 minutes on each side until golden brown.


